1. The board heard a presentation by Cort Dogniez about the work he is doing in Park West School Division as it relates to integration of First Nation and Metis perspective into all curriculum. He shared some of the initiatives/projects occurring in the division, resources that have been purchased, and teacher training that has been provided. Cort has done some tremendous work for Park West in this area.
Cort also informed the board that he has been offered a full time position with Saskatoon Catholic School Board and therefore he will not be back next year. He told the board how much he loved working in Park West for the last four years, how much he felt supported in his work and how much progress has been made. We will miss Cort's leadership and wisdom. We wish him well in his new job.
2. Major Pratt School had a presentation for the board. Mr. Cole, the acting principal, provided a power point focusing on a day in the life at Major Pratt School.
