1. The board passed a motion to pay for the registration fee for two Parent Advisory Committee members per school who are interested in attending the Manitoba Association of Parent Council Conference.
2. The board was informed that the Motor Carrier Enforcement division will be conducting an audit of our transportation system. This is to ensure compliance with all the provincial regulations. This kind of audit is done periodically by the province. We are scheduled for our audit in April.
3. The Assistant Superintendent attended a Workplace Safety and Health session. At the session a former member of the Winnipeg Police service presented information on thinking/procedure in regards to lockdown procedures. We are going to schedule him to come and talk to principals and trustees.
4. Tourism Day occurred on March 21st at the Asessippi Ski Hill. Students from across the division heard presentations from various regional tourism businesses and industries. A grant for this event was provided by the Rural Secretariat. Special thanks to Lindsay Rubeniuk, Vocational Coordinator, for organizing this event.
5. Trustees shared information about sessions they attended at the Manitoba School Boards Association (MSBA) Conference. Students from Park West School Division were recognized with the MSBA citizenship awards at the Celebration of Success evening. Great to see our students get provincial recognition.
6. The fibre optic project is progressing. An information evening was held on March 21st that gave RM reps a chance to ask questions. RMs have until April 4th to decide if they want to participate in the project.
