



Small School Budget Allocations

The Park West School Division believes in resourcing schools based on needs and individual circumstance. School budget allocations have often been based on student count. This method of budget allocation can cause disparity and hardship for small schools.

In order to support small schools and ensure that they are adequately resourced, the following will be instituted:

1. Base funding will be provided in the following manner:
 - 0-75 students \$2,500
 - 76-125 students \$1,500
2. The Superintendent/CEO may allocate additional funds to a small school to help support/purchase special one-time items. For example: score clocks, technology, etc. (This money would be from a discretionary fund or re-allocated from within the current divisional budget)
3. The Superintendent/CEO or designate may adjust staffing above formula to support programming needs.
