Re: **Website information on the Office of the Commissioner of Teacher Professional Conduct**

As you will be aware, on January 6, 2025, amendments to The Education Administration Act came into force establishing a new teacher conduct framework, led by the independent Office of the Commissioner of Teacher Professional Conduct. The Commissioner has authority to investigate complaints and reports regarding the conduct and competence of all Manitoba certified teachers and school clinicians.


In the months following, my office has received feedback from some sector partners and child advocacy organizations indicating that the existence and role of the Commissioner may not be well known within the broader community. To support transparency and public confidence, and to enhance reporting in the interest of greater student safety, I am requesting per subsection 41(1)(y) of The Public Schools Act that school division and funded independent school websites include the following statement:

"Manitoba Education and Early Childhood Learning has created the **Office of the Commissioner of Teacher Professional Conduct** to review concerns about the professional conduct or competence of certified teachers and school clinicians.
