



ICT Teacher Leader

Position Summary

The ICT Teacher Leader supports PWSD students and staff with the effective use of technology for teaching and learning. The teacher leader focuses on providing job-embedded support for teachers, which may include classroom visits and one-on-one meetings with teachers. ICT support may involve co-teaching or co-planning with individual teachers, small group or divisional professional development sessions.

Responsibilities and Duties:

The ICT Teacher Leader will:

- Coach and support school administrators and teachers on technology-integration in K-12 curriculum
- Establish positive relationships with students and staff in order to better support them with using technology
- Demonstrate a good understanding of Manitoba Education's Literacy with ICT model
- Develop or curate classroom projects which promote the development of Literacy with ICT skills and support the implementation of such projects in PWSD classrooms
- Highlight ICT projects and exemplary technology-integration through sharing online and in-person
- Provide leadership and planning for professional development with a focus on technology-integration
- Work with the divisional ICT Team to support divisional planning for the meaningful integration of technology in PWSD schools.
- Work closely with the ICT Supervisor and technicians to develop ICT guidelines, implement new technologies and provide technical support
- Represent Park West School Division in technology-related organizations and committees
- Participate in technology conferences and other professional learning opportunities to remain current on both pedagogical practices and technology tools
- Investigate emerging technologies and evaluate their usefulness in a K-12 education setting
- Work with the ICT Team to provide current information to staff about technology tools, policies and ICT projects
