



Recognition for Special Accomplishments

The Park West School Division recognizes that within the Division there are individual and collective accomplishments of students and/or staff that are exceptional and that result in an opportunity to compete or make presentations in a public forum at the local, provincial, and/or national levels.

The special accomplishments of students and/or staff in school-related activities may be recognized through a variety of methods, including, but not restricted to:

- a. letter of acknowledgement
- b. presentation of a certificate
- c. allocation of funds to offset the costs of registration fees, transportation, accommodation, and/or incidental expenses.
- d. gift or token of appreciation

The allocation of funds to offset the total costs may be provided for students and/or staff who have attained recognition for special accomplishment and have been selected to represent the Division at out-of-province/in-province activities in national or provincial competitions, or to make presentations on behalf of the Division.

It shall be the responsibility of the Superintendent/CEO to recognize such accomplishments and to report his/her acknowledgements to the Board.
