Topic: **Executive Summary of the November 18th Regular Board Meeting**

1. A delegation from Birtle Collegiate presented an overview of their work in supporting the mental wellbeing of students.
2. The Board defeated a motion related to a out-of-catchment transportation request.
3. The Board passes a motion to complete an internal review of transportation catchment areas with a report shared with the public by June 1, 2022.
4. The Division will be allowing community use of schools for activities involving K-12 students exclusively, effective January 2022. This will include things such as club sports, cadets, etc. The current provincial health order for vaccination and testing will apply.
5. On December 3, there was a full-day professional development session for teachers focused on trauma-informed teaching.
6. The Secretary-Treasurer has been supporting the PWSD Foundation board in evaluating investment options for its endowed funds and working on recruiting project leaders for PWSD's Canada Learning Bond uptake project.
7. The Board acknowledged the male and female teams from both Hamiota Collegiate and Major Pratt School who competed in the recent provincial volleyball championships. Additional recognition was given to both the girls' teams from each school who are provincial champions in A and AA volleyball.
8. The Board of Trustees has approved the return of the Mental Wellness Worker position effective January 10, 2022 to March 25, 2022.
9. A biannual meeting is scheduled for December 14 focusing on the educational partnership between Park West School Division and Waywayseecappo First Nation.
