## **Community Use of Schools:**

• The pause on community use of schools has been extended to November 1. We will reevaluate this prior to the end of the month.

 This pause on community use is consistent with current divisional restrictions on nonessential visitors, volunteers, and activities involving external groups or organizations.

## **New Mask Guidance from the Province:**

- Manitoba Education and Public Health have updated the mask requirement for schools with clarification when masks may be removed.
- Effective Monday, October 4, masks must be worn full-time including when students are separated by 2 metres.
- It was confirmed at a meeting for school divisions on Wednesday that physical distancing no longer means automatic mask removal. The statement from the province regarding this is shown below:
  - Masks may be removed indoors where there is physical distancing of 2 metres for the purpose of eating, drinking, and for short, infrequent masks breaks. Masks may be removed when outside - (https://www.edu.gov.mb.ca/k12/covid/).
