**Topic:** **Executive Summary of June 11, 2026, Regular Board Meeting**

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1. Trustees and senior administration will attend a biannual meeting with Waywayseecappo education staff and Chief and Council. These meetings are part of our ongoing partnership.
2. Effective September 2026, all schools will incorporate a framework for teaching digital citizenship and online safety to all students. The content is designed to cover required topics like responsible technology use, privacy, cyberbullying prevention, critical thinking online, and healthy screen habits.
3. Five online high school courses will be delivered next year, including Topics & Trends in Business, Applied Mathematics, 40S, Personal Finance 20S, Land and Treaties 40S, and Psychology 40S. These provide additional timetable options for our smaller high schools.
4. The Secretary Treasurer presented fuel tenders and brought forward the design of three capital projects for board approval. Key implementation tasks for the Secretary-Treasurer included the launch and staff training for Amazon Business, progressing the financial management software replacement, and submitting grant applications for five school play structures.
5. Based on feedback from participating teachers, improvements to the New Teacher Mentorship program will be made for the upcoming school year including enhancements to the onboarding process.
6. Park West's provincial nutrition funding allocation remains unchanged from the previous year. Schools will continue to use these funds to support barrier-free snack, breakfast, and/or lunch programs for students.
7. The Board discussed a recent letter from the Terry Fox Foundation that highlighted the fundraising of local schools.
8. Trustees reviewed plans and timelines leading up to the next school board election in October.
9. Our next regular board meeting is scheduled for September 10, 2026.
