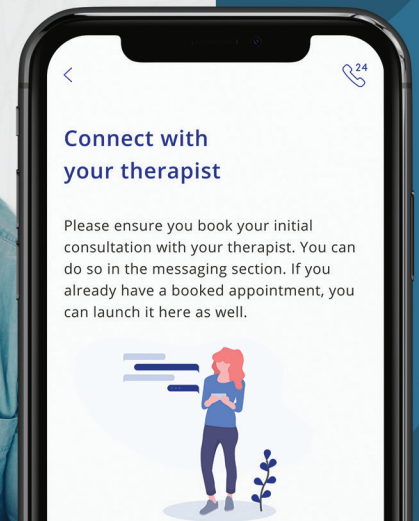


Help for anxiety.
