**Topic:** **Executive Summary of December 11, 2025, Regular Board Meeting**

1. There was no school for students on the divisional PD on Monday, December 8. Teachers met in their Professional Learning Communities. Bus drivers and custodians gathered for Treaty Training in Birtle. Rebecca Okemow, a teacher from Waywayseecappo School, facilitated the training.
2. School nominations for the divisional citizenship awards are due on December 19.
3. The Board received an update on the new K-8 Literacy Framework.
4. A team consisting of five divisional Kindergarten teachers, the Student Services Coordinator, and the Assistant Superintendent met to begin revisions on the PWSD Kindergarten report card.
5. The secretary treasurer provided an update regarding the PWSD June 30 Year-End Audit, noting that the finalization of the audit with MNP is currently underway. Correspondence was also reviewed, including an update from MSBA regarding the Valuation of Properties process.
6. Trustees shared perspective on the MSBA Fall PD Day on November 24, 2025, in Winnipeg.
7. The Manitoba Education Winter 2026 newsletter was received as correspondence. It referenced significant investments in the early learning sector, including progress toward creating 23,000 child care spaces. Key K-12 education updates include the legislative requirement for early reading screening under Bill 225, the introduction of a Grade 12 Treaty Education course, and the release of new resources for Holocaust education.
8. The next regular meeting of the Board is Thursday, January 8, 2026.
9. The Board extends wishes for safe, enjoyable, and restful holiday season for all students, staff, and families.
